

NRA National Summer Camp 4-Position Smallbore Rifle Postal Match

This postal match offers all summer camps a postal match program designed to encourage and reward individual marksmanship skills.



ELIGIBILITY

An individual may enter this match only once per calendar year. Membership in the NRA is not required, but is encouraged.

CATEGORIES

Competitors will enter in only one of the following categories

- ◆ Adult — ages 21 years and up
- ◆ Junior — ages 15 - 21
- ◆ Sub-Junior — ages 14 and under

DEADLINE DATES

Entry forms may be requested from the NRA starting June 1. Firing may be conducted anytime between the time you get the match firing report and August 20. All envelopes containing targets and firing reports being returned to NRA for final scoring must be postmarked not later than August 25. Score reports and targets received postmarked after that date will not be accepted.

FEES

\$ 50.00 per camp

RULES

In all cases not covered by these conditions, the current *NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules* will apply. Rulebooks may be ordered from the NRA Program Materials Center at (800) 336-7402 or online at <http://materials/nrahq.org/go>. Request item number CR 16750.

EQUIPMENT

Any .22 caliber rimfire (Rule 3.2 of the *NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules*). Metallic sights may be used (Rule 3.7(a) of the *NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules*).

DISTANCE

50 feet

TARGETS

NRA A-17 targets are required. Only one shot is fired on each record bullseye. Target acquisition is the responsibility of the camp. For a list of NRA licensed target manufacturers, visit the NRA's Web site at www.nrahq.org/compete/licensed.asp.

COURSE OF FIRE

40 shots

- ◆ 10 shots prone
- ◆ 10 shots sitting
- ◆ 10 shots kneeling
- ◆ 10 shots standing

Ten shots per target are to be fired by each competitor.

SCORING

Target may be scored by the coach. All targets will be reviewed by the NRA, and those scores will be final.

AWARDS

National Trophy plaques will be provided for first place in each category. (There must be a minimum of two competitors for 1st Place to be awarded.) Additional awards will be provided for each additional ten competitors in each category.

ADMINISTRATION

Each target must contain the shooter's name and position fired. Please print the required information on the front or back of the target. (Typed labels are acceptable.)

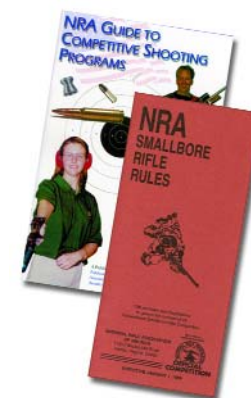
