

AWARDS

Awards will be provided for both the Smallbore and Air Rifle Matches.

National Awards – A plaque will be awarded by the NRA to the top three scorers in each category.

Camp Awards – A Camp Rifle Champion belt buckle will be awarded by the NRA to the top-scoring individual in each category from each participating camp at the conclusion of the camping season.

Weekly Awards – NRA - BSA Camp Rifle Champion hatpins and certificates will be awarded immediately to the top scorers in each category at the end of each week of competition by the sponsoring camp. These items will be furnished by the NRA.

**NRA - BSA NATIONAL
CAMP RIFLE
POSTAL MATCHES**

PURPOSE

In cooperation with the Boy Scouts of America, the NRA has established a series of Smallbore Rifle and Air Rifle postal matches. The matches will be fired on a weekly basis up to eight (8) weeks. Each week an incoming group of campers will have an opportunity to enter the match for that week.

CATEGORIES

Competitors will enter only one of the following categories (ages as of December 27th):

Junior - 1st year camper (age limit 13)

Senior - 2nd or 3rd year campers (age limit 17)

FIRING DATES

The matches will be fired on a weekly basis and will be season long -- up to 8 weeks. This gives each incoming group of campers an opportunity to enter the match for that week.

ENTRY CLOSING DATE

All firing reports must be submitted to NRA headquarters **postmarked no later than August 16th. Scores may be e-mailed to postals@nrahq.org or faxed to (703) 267-3941. Any scores received after August 16th, may not be included in the results.** Please PRINT each scouts name CLEARLY on the reporting sheet.

ENTRY FEE (per Camp)

4 weeks or less (total fee). \$30.00

5 or more weeks (total fee). \$40.00

(This includes entry for both junior and senior shooters for the specified number of weeks).

MATCH CONDITIONS

Eye and ear protection are required by BSA Shooting Council at all BSA ranges.

RULES

In all cases not covered by the conditions in this program, current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules (item #CR 16750) and the NRA Sporter Air Rifle Position Rules (item #CA 16320) will govern in these matches. Rulebooks may be ordered by calling NRA sales at (800) 336-7402 or on-line at

EQUIPMENT

Smallbore Rifle - .22 caliber rimfire rifles will be used.

Air Rifle - .177 caliber air rifles will be used.

TARGETS

A-17 rifle targets are required for Smallbore Rifle; AR-5/10 for Air Rifle matches. The camp must furnish NRA Official targets. Targets may be obtained from shooting supply dealers or directly from the manufacturers. For a list of licensed NRA target manufacturers, visit:

TARGET VALIDATION

Shooters will sign their targets prior to firing the match. Camps are no longer required to send fired targets to NRA.

COURSES OF FIRE

Smallbore Rifle:

Outdoor range at 50 feet

Juniors: 10 shots prone supported or bench rest (weekly)

Seniors: 20 shots prone supported or bench rest (weekly)

Air Rifle

Outdoor range at 10 meters (33 feet)

Juniors: 10 shots prone or bench supported (weekly)

Seniors: 20 shots prone or bench supported (weekly)

SCORING

The sponsoring camp will conduct all scoring.

WITNESS

All firing must be done on an approved Scout camp range under qualified supervision in accordance with BSA National Camp School Standards.
