

NRA/Royal Rangers Trapshooting Postal Match

Purpose

The purpose of this postal match is to offer Royal Rangers throughout the country an opportunity to participate in a nationwide trapshooting postal match.

Prerequisite

It is recommended that the shotgun safety merit be complete.

Eligibility

An individual may enter this match only once per calendar year. All competitors must be a member of a current chartered outpost.

Categories

Junior: 14-15 years of age in the calendar year of competition

Senior: 16-18* years of age in the calendar year of competition

Adult: Must be members of a church that has a chartered outpost.

***To compete as an 18 year old senior the competitor must be an expedition member and may not be serving as a Lt. Commander in the outpost.**

Awards

Winner — A trophy plaque with the Postal Logo will be mailed to the highest scorer in each category. Second through fifth places will receive awards based on participation.

Additional awards will be provided for each additional 10 competitors in a category.

Firing Dates

Competition will commence on January 1 of each calendar year and will end on October 31. All targets must be returned and postmarked by November 15.

Firing may be conducted any time after score reporting forms are received from NRA.

Fees

\$5.00 per entry. Each shooter will receive a participation certificate.

Rules

Current Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA) Rules will govern. Rule books may be obtained by contacting the Amateur Trapshooting Association, 601 W. National Road, Vandalia, Ohio 45377 or at (937) 898-4638.

Equipment

Any shotgun, 12 gauge or smaller may be used.

Targets

Standard clay targets will be used.

Course of Fire

16 Yard Singles, 100 Targets

Participants must fire 5 shots at each station from 16 yards. The course will be repeated four consecutive times. The course may be fired over several days.

Shooters must declare to the assigned Witness prior to firing the match that it will count as his entry into the postal match.

Witness

All record firing must be witnessed by an adult Advisor.

Scoring

All scoring will be in accordance with ATA rules. In case of a tie, duplicate awards will be given.

Match Conditions

Eye protection is required during this event by the Royal Rangers.

Administration

Complete the entry form attached and return to the Competitive Shooting Division. You will receive score reporting forms to record the match scores and individual participation certificates. Return reporting forms and entry fees, to the NRA (see next page for address).

Match Bulletin

The NRA will compile a match bulletin and provide one to each address on the entry form. The bulletin will specify national and category winners and also provide rank listing of all competitors according to categories.

Royal Rangers will publish results on the Royal Ranger Web site.

Results will be available after December 15.
