NRA COLLEGIATE COACH RECOGNITION AWARDS- 2012

- WHY?** The purpose of this program is to provide recognition for outstanding persons involved in collegiate shooting sports programs.
- WHO?** All collegiate coaches and instructors, whether paid or volunteer are eligible.
- WHAT?** Two different types of awards:
1. *NRA Distinguished College Coach* - Selection will be based on record of achievement and success of team during the year, and other criteria.
 2. *Outstanding Service To Collegiate Shooting Sports* - Selection will be based on work done towards growth and development of a collegiate shooting sports program whether it be for physical education classes, recreation/leisure, club or varsity team, or a combination.
- WHEN?** **Forms should be received at NRA no later than close of business on February 24, 2012.**
Selection will be made prior to March 08, 2012.
- FROM?** Nominations will be accepted from students, faculty, school administrators, other college coaches, athletic directors or others who are involved with a collegiate shooting sports program. Additional support letters from third parties are accepted.

A. *Distinguished College Coach* questions:

1. What are the most prominent or evident reasons why your nominee should be given the Distinguished College Coach award?
2. What are the team/individual season records in competition for the last three years?
3. Give a historical summary of your nominee's coaching career. Include credentials, experience, service, past records?
4. What are the coaching program responsibilities? Expound on curriculum, recreation and/or competition.
5. What are the outstanding contributions your nominee has made to the shooting team or shooting program in development, expansion, fund-raising, cooperation with the university administration or local community effort, and by what means are they measured? Limit your response to this year's activities.
6. List any other pertinent information about your nominee.

B. *Outstanding Service to Collegiate Shooting Sports* questions:

1. What are the most prominent or evident reasons why this nominee should be given the Outstanding Service award?
2. Give a historical summary of your nominee's contributions to collegiate shooting. Include such things as match operations or sponsorship, coaching experience, committee participation, range development, and development of collegiate shooting sports programs.
3. What are the outstanding contributions the nominee has made to a shooting team or the collegiate program in development, expansion, fund-raising, support and cooperation with university administration or local community efforts, and by what means are they measured?
