4. Videotaping or taking still photographs with the intent of showing participants and/or coaches, non-participants, spectators, event layouts.
5. Using physical gestures and/or electronic equipment (i.e. walkie talkies, two-way pagers, or other messaging/communications equipment) with the intent of assisting individuals participating in events.
