In order to enroll your agency in the "NRA Law Enforcement Training and Qualification Program", the organization must employ and assign range duties to, at least one certified NRA Law Enforcement Firearm Instructor. Individual NRA Membership is required to be maintained by your instructor in order to maintain his/her firearm certification.

In order for the organization to issue NRA Training and/or Qualification Certificates, your training and/or qualification program must first be reviewed, approved by, and registered with, the National Rifle Association's Law Enforcement Division. The organization may then purchase and issue NRA Training Certificates or NRA Qualification Certificates. NRA Law Enforcement Training and Qualification Certificates may be purchased from the NRA's Program Materials Website at <http://materials.nrahq.org>.

In order for your organization to conduct NRA sanctioned Police Pistol Combat Tournaments (Approved, Registered, State Championships and Regional's), the host agency MUST affiliate with the NRA as a club. Individual membership is no longer required to compete.

The purpose and objectives of the National Rifle Association are:

1. To protect and defend the Constitution of the United States, especially with reference to the inalienable right of the individual American citizen guaranteed by such Constitution to acquire, transport, carry, transfer ownership of, and enjoy the right to use arms, in order that the people may always be in position to exercise their legitimate individual rights to self-preservation and defense of family, person, property, as well s to serve effectively in the appropriate militia for the common defense of the Republic and the individual liberty of its citizens;
2. To promote public safety, law and order, and the national defense;
3. To train members of law enforcement agencies, the armed forces, the militia, and people in good repute in marksmanship and in the safe handling and efficient use of small arms;
4. To foster and support the shooting sports, including the advancement of amateur competitions in marksmanship at the local, state, national, and international levels.
5. To promote hunter safety, and to promote and defend hunting as a shooting sport and as a viable and necessary method of fostering the propagation, growth, conservation, and wise use of our renewable wildlife resources.
6. The Association may take all actions necessary and proper in furtherance of these purposes and objectives.
